Paula was an educator, social activist and dedicated member of the Unitarian Church. Both were tireless advocates for the disenfranchised members of our community.

Essay Topic:

Write an essay in which you describe any of your activities that have helped people in need.

We would like to hear about what motivated you to engage in these activities, what they were, and what you felt about them—before you began, while you were doing them, and after they were completed.

You may have had conflicted feelings, for example, and the actual experience of working on the project may have been different from what you thought it would be.

Do your best to make your experience come to life for your readers.

Finally, we would be interested in any kinds of lessons you learned through your experience in this or similar projects.

Essay length: maximum 1000 words, there is no minimum.

Eligibility:

The competition is open to all high school students in Louisiana. In order to be eligible, all writers must mail a copy of the certification form below, signed by the student's English/Language Arts teacher. You can also download the form at www.bienvillehousecenter.org
